- The new UPS store mailbox can be used for:

- Snap Raise fundraiser
 - District said ok for the Booster Club but not ASB
 - Will send a representative to Booster Club meeting on Nov. 12th
- Bowen Scarff –no info.
- Recycled clothing fundraiser-the company said the market price per pound is too low; check prices after the first of the year
 - Wendy will call the Clothing Textile Recycling referred to her to see if it is a different organization than the one that Football used last year
- McDonald's, Wendy's, Menchies, and Panda Express fundraisers are better suited for individual member groups; umbrella Booster Club will provide information to member groups
- Fred Meyer Community Rewards
 - Must have rewards card

 - Make an account and link your rewards card to non-profit (you can only link to one group)
 - Organization receives money based on proportion of purchases made on linked reward cards
 - Kim is going to prepare info for the groups on the Fred Meyer community rewards
- We will man a table to provide info about the Booster Club at home games during winter sports
- 1 Green Planet recycling fundraiser
 - Market campaign starts 3 weeks before the Dec. 6 event
 - Flyers in all the elementary schools and middle schools
 - A blurb was sent in for the November newsletter
 - Daily bulletin needs to go in 1 week prior
 - Notice on KR website and calendar
 - Notices on the Electronic boards 1 week prior, and then confirm
 - Check with Eric Anderson about skyward e-mail
 - Check with Jane Walburn (DECA)- she may have a class assignment to have the kids publish the notices on the electronic bulletin boards=Al will check into this
 - Post on Craig's List
 - Set up a table at 11/25 conferences-kids can support while we are in conference with teachers
 - Check with businesses like Safeway and Starbucks about putting up info about the event
 - Anita mentioned possibility of using Square D payment swipe machine
 - Would need 2-3 adults to man the event
 - Students can use participation at event as service hours with signature by booster officials
- We need to have active approval of the minutes instead of passive approval
